The petitioners had filed CWP No.3682 of 2015, seeking direction to the respondents to take a decision on their representation dated 15.01.2014. The said petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 02.03.2015 (**Annexure P-6**) with a direction to the respondent(s) to take decision on the representation dated 15.01.2014, submitted by the petitioners, by passing a speaking order, preferably within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, reply has been filed, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned Counsel for the petitioner.

In the reply, it is submitted that the claim of the petitioners has been considered and the same has been rejected by passing a speaking order dated 28.02.2017/02.03.2017 (**Annexure R-1**).

Learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions were to pass speaking order, which stands complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
