Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 4.2.2016 passed by the Collector. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case was remanded to Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector, Gurdaspur for decision afresh. Thereafter, said authority adjourned the case sine-die. According to him Assistant Collector has not acted in accordance with the directions of the Collector. Thus a case for contempt of this court is made out. This plea is untenable. The petition is totally frivolous in nature. It is inexplicable why the petitioner has invoked the contempt jurisdiction of this court while disobedience of the order passed by the Collector is alleged. Filing of such frivolous petitions need to be discouraged. Same is dismissed with Rs.10,000/- as costs.
