In the writ petition bearing CWP No. 7184 of 2015 filed by the petitioner, this Court vide order dated 21.04.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) passed the following operative directions:-

“After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No. 1 to take a decision on the representation dated 21.08.2014 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.”

Upon notice, a reply has been filed wherein it is stated that in

compliance of the order dated 21.04.2015 (**P-1**), the competent authority has

passed a detailed speaking order No. 8 of 2016 (**Annexure R-1**), and the same has been conveyed to the petitioners.

In view of the above, no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, accordingly, present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
