DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order dated 14.7.2017 passed by this Court, a specific direction was issued to respondent No.2 to take cognizance of the petitioner's grievance, whereas, no action has been taken.

Neither any representation has been placed on record by learned counsel for the petitioner nor any direction has been issued by this Court vide order dated 14.7.2017 to take action on the representation. No case is made out for attracting the provisions of Contempt of Courts Act. However, the petitioner is at liberty to move detailed representation to the competent authority i.e. Superintendent of Police, Ambala within a period of four weeks from today. In case such representation is moved by the petitioner within the stipulated period, the respondent is directed to take action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of one month thereafter.
