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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

The petitioner is working as E.T.T. Teacher. Her amount of C.P.F. deducted from the salary along with the State's contribution was, however, being incorrectly deposited by the Department in someone else's account. The CWP No.8168 of 2015 filed by the petitioner seeking the relief of correction of that mistake resulted to passing an order dated 06.05.2015, directing the respondents to rectify the mistake within three months from the receipt of certified copy of that order.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for respondent No.2/Bank submits that the necessary correction has been made by the BDPO concerned on whose direction, the Bank has also taken the necessary action.

In view of the statement made by learned Counsel for respondent No.2/Bank, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

However, liberty is given to the petitioner to revive the present contempt petition in case the needful has not been done.
