DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned State counsel submits that order passed by this Court on 3.11.2014 in CWP No. 22416 of 2014 could not be complied with as the amount which was required to be deposited by the petitioners have not been deposited by them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the amount which was to be deposited has to be specified by the respondents.

The respondents are directed to intimate the petitioners as to how much amount has to be deposited by them. The necessary exercise be done within a period of two weeks from today and thereafter the petitioners are directed to deposit the said amount within a period of two weeks

thereafter.

In case, said exercise is done within the stipulated time, then respondents are directed to comply with the order within a period of one month thereafter.

Contempt petition stands disposed of.

In case the order passed by this Court in the writ petition as well as the directions issued today in the contempt petition are not complied with, the petitioners are at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
