On the asking of court, Mr.R.K.S.Brar, Addl.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 20.4.2017 passed by the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“In the circumstances, this writ petition is allowed and the respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioner for regularization of his services from the date services of his juniors (as mentioned in para 6 of the petition) were regularized. Necessary exercise be carried out within two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case no appeal is pending against the order passed by the writ court, it shall be implemented forthwith in any case not later than two months.

In view of statement made by him, this petition is disposed of.
