Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in compliance of order passed by this Court, the case of the petitioner has been considered and arrears of pay protection amounting to ₹3,24,861/- (3,16,941 + 7920) and ₹1,90,692/- have been deposited in the account of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the respondents has also placed on record the certificate dated 24.4.2017 duly signed by the petitioner in this regard.
