This petition has been filed for initiating the contempt proceedings against respondent in view of directions issued by this Court in CRM-M-12638 of 2016 as the respondent has not acted in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the statement of the petitioner was recorded and no order has been conveyed to him.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner and have also perused the order passed on 12.04.2016 which shows that a direction was issued to respondent No.3 to take note of the contents of representation and to act in accordance with law. Nowhere, it is mentioned in the order that any decision was to be conveyed to the petitioner but simply, it has been mentioned that the respondent is to consider the representation and to act in accordance with law. The only thing which can

be inferred from the order and the arguments raised by learned counsel for the petitioner is that the decision taken has not been conveyed to the petitioner.

No ground is made out to initiate the contempt proceedings against the respondent.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, the respondent is directed to convey the decision to the petitioner, which has been taken in pursuance of order dated 12.04.2016.
