DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that in compliance of order passed by this Court on 11.7.2014, the amount has been released to the petitioners, whereas, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are also entitled for interest as there is a delay of about three and a half years in making the payment.

Since there is no direction regarding interest in order dated 11.7.2014, the petitioners are at liberty to move representation to the respondent-authorities. In case such representation is made within a period of one month from today, the respondents are directed to consider the same within a period of one month thereafter.

In case the petitioners are still aggrieved, they are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy.

Disposed of accordingly.
