Short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. M.S. Narang, Managing Director, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

In the reply, it has been mentioned that in compliance of order dated 8.7.2014 passed by this Court, an amount of ₹3,81,027/- towards 25% back wages and interest @ 9 % after deducting TDS has been released and necessary compliance of the order has been made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that how the payment has been calculated has not been mentioned in the reply.

Since the compliance of the order has been made, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to move representation to the respondent.

In case any representation is made regarding difference in calculation of amount within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order, the respondent is directed to consider the same within a period of one month thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
