The petitioners/Head Teacher(s)/Primary Teacher(s) had filed CWP No.10073 of 2016 seeking directions to the respondents to decide the Legal Notice. The said petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the Legal Notice of the petitioners and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law, expeditiously. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of the respondents has been filed, wherein it is submitted that all the arrears/medical bills of the petitioners have been cleared by the DDO of the Govt. High School, Chhatehra vide speaking order dated 24.10.2016 (**Annexure R-1**).

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the aforesaid directions have already been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned opposite Counsel.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

The petitioners are given liberty to revive the present contempt petition in case there is some discrepancy in the admissible benefits.
