Learned State counsel, on instructions from the official of the department, submits that the recommendation has been made by the Commission and the appointment letter will be issued to the petitioners within a period of two months from today.

Keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to make necessary compliance within a period of two weeks from today.

In case, the compliance is not made within a period of two weeks from today then the petitioners will be entitled to claim Rs.10,000/- per day till the appointment letter is issued to them and the same shall be recoverable from the officials, who are instrumental in delaying the matter.

Respondent is also directed to grant the consequential benefits to the petitioners in pursuance of directions issued in the writ petition.
