On asking of the court, Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.  
Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 27.3.2017, passed by  
the writ court, operative part thereof reads as under:-

“Accordingly, the respondents-authorities are directed that the amount so recovered be refunded to the petitioner with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of recovery, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the needful is not done within a period of three months, then the respondents-authorities shall be liable to pay the amount so recovered with interest @ 9% per annum from the date of recovery.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case no appeal is pending against the aforesaid order, same shall be complied with at the earliest, in any case not later than one month. In case it is found that

any fresh cause of action arises to the petitioner to invoke contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed, which shall be deducted from the salary of the official(s) responsible for delay/non-compliance.
