On the asking of court, Mr.Rohit Arya, AAG, Haryana accepts
notice on behalf of State of Haryana.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 2.3.2017. Operative
part thereof reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that they will file comprehensive representations to the Director, Urban Estates, Haryana within two weeks. After filing thereof the same shall be considered and decided by the competent authority within a period of three months from the date of receipt thereof after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioners. Till such time the representations are decided, the status quo granted by this court shall continue.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case matter
has not been decided till now, decision thereof shall be taken expeditiously
in any case not later than two months.

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In view of statement made by him, no further direction is necessary.

Disposed of.

However, in case a fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner for invoking contempt jurisdiction of this court, it shall consider imposition of exemplary costs which shall be deducted from the salary of the officers responsible for delay/non compliance.
