The present contempt petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act for punishing the respondent for non-compliance of order passed by this Court on 03.03.1994 in CWP No.2902 of 1994.

CWP No.2902 of 1994 came up for hearing on 03.12.2013 and following order was passed.

“ Counsel for the petitioner states that during pendency of this writ petition, the land in dispute was purchased by the petitioner and sale was authenticated by the SDM concerned on 15.3.1994. Copy of the order has been placed on record. Counsel states that in view of above, this writ petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.”

Keeping in view the order passed in CWP No.2902 of 1994, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is dismissed as having become infructuous.
