On asking of the court, Mr. Harsimran Singh Sethi, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter can be disposed of in the same terms as the order passed in COCF No.737 of 2017.

Grievance of the petitioner is that minimum of the pay scale is not being granted to the petitioner despite the fact that order in this regard has attained finality.

Learned State counsel submits that needful shall be done at the earliest in any case not later than 3 months.

Under the circumstances, no further direction is necessary. This court hopes and trust that the contempt would be purged by that time. In the eventuality, this does not happen, petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition. The court would in that case consider imposition of exemplary costs which would be deducted from the salary of the officers responsible for delay.
