JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

In the writ petition bearing CWP No. 2622 of 2013 filed by
the petitioner, this Court vide order dated 09.09.2013 (**Annexure P-4**)
passed the following operative directions:-

*“At this stage, this petition is disposed of with a direction
that all consequential financial benefits accruing to the
petitioner on his regularization w.e.f. October 1, 2003 be
released to the petitioner within a period of three months after
the receipt of certified copy of this order. Copy of the letter
dated May 8, 2013 is made part of the record.”*

Upon notice, a reply has been filed from which the inevitable
conclusion is that the abovesaid order dated 09.09.2013 (**P-4**) has been
complied with. As regards the claim of the petitioner for entitlement of a

different relief based on the assertion that he held the post of technical nature and was entitled to a better scale, was not a subject matter of the relief granted.

In view of the above, no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, accordingly, present petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
