There are 06 petitioners-retirees who were claiming arrears of Leave Encashment and Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity in terms of the order dated 23.03.2012 passed in CWP No.3672 of 2012 and CWP No.7077 of 2004 read with order dated 05.01.2012 in CWP No.23138 of 2010 and order dated 25.11.2014 passed in COCP No.3481 of 2012.

It is a conceded position that claim of five petitioners except Sh. Bikkar Singh (petitioner no.4) entire arrears of the retiral benefits i.e. leave encashment and death cum retirement gratuity have been released. The bills relating to the DCRG of petitioner no.4-Sh. Bikkar Singh is pending in the treasury and the required payments are expected to be paid

shortly.

In view of the aforesaid stand, contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. The respondent-State shall be bound by their by their aforesaid statement qua petitioner no.4-Sh. Bikkar Singh.
