The claim of the petitioner, working as Clerk in the Social Justice & Empowerment Department, Haryana, for grant of 2nd ACP Scales w.e.f. 01.12.2013 after completion of 20 years' service as Clerk was required to be granted in compliance of the order dated 10.03.2015, passed in RSA No.4809 of 2014, whereby the concurrent findings recorded in favour of the petitioner by the trial Court and the Appellate Court were affirmed by this Court. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Learned Counsel for the parties are agreed that the necessary relief has since been granted vide order dated 14.12.2016, appended as **Annexure A-1** with the reply dated 22.12.2016 filed by Sh. Sanjeev Verma, Director, Social Justice & Empowerment, Haryana.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
