On the asking of court, Mr. Harsimran Singh Sethi,
Addl.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioners allege violation of order 25.8.2017. Operative part
thereof reads as under:-

“If that is so, the writ petition is disposed of
with a direction to respondent No.2 to give a copy of the
appellate order dated 23.9.2016 to the petitioners as early
as possible but not later than one week from the date of
receiving a certified copy of this order. The petitioners
shall thereafter be at liberty to avail further remedy.

Till such time, status-quo is ordered to be
maintained.”

Learned State counsel submits that in case aforesaid order has
not been complied with, needful shall be done at the earliest in any case
not later than 2 weeks.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. However,
in case, any fresh cause of action accrue to the petitioners for contempt,
this court shall consider imposition of exemplary costs.
