The petitioner-Company, through its Director, had filed CWP No.614 of 2016 seeking directions to the respondent(s) to issue NOC/Marketing and Sale Permission, if any, to sell CENTROGOLD and Centrozyme i.e. Bio-Products of the petitioner-Company in the State of Punjab as these Bio-Products do not come either under the Insecticides Act, 1968 or Fertilizer Control Order, 1985; further prayer for granting ad-interim stay, restraining the respondents from stopping the petitioner-Company to sell the aforesaid Bio-Products and further seeking directions to the respondents not to interfere with the business of the petitioner-Company as well as of its Dealers. The said petition was disposed of permitting the petitioner-Company to seek permission in terms of the detailed order passed in **CWP No.12536 of 2011** titled as “**M/s Biostadt India Ltd. Vs. State of Haryana and others**”. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition as the aforesaid directions stand complied with.

In view of the statement made at bar, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
