Petitioner-Sant Singh, while working as Inspector Grade-I, on conclusion of disciplinary proceedings was dismissed from service vide order dated 18.05.1998; the punishment order was finally partly allowed by the Appellate Authority vide order dated 13.07.2011, whereby the termination order was set aside and the petitioner was ordered to be reinstated, however, with no monetary benefits at all.

In the writ petition filed by the petitioner, challenging the appellate order dated 13.07.2011, this Court vide order dated 24.04.2015 disposed of the petition with the directions that the respondents shall grant benefit to the petitioner, as had been granted to others forty-four (44) similarly situated co-delinquent employees.

Since the necessary exercise was not done within the stipulated period of three months, the present contempt petition was filed.

At the time of hearing, it is conceded by the counsel for petitioner that payment of all the arrears of salary due with effect from the date of termination till the date of reinstatement, as also for the prior suspension period w.e.f. 22.11.1995 to 17.05.1998 has since been released. He further submits that the claim of the petitioner for grant of ACP scales, as admissible to the employees of PUNSUP, has not yet been considered and sanctioned.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the petitioner has superannuated on 30.04.2008, and his claim for grant of ACP scales during his service period shall be considered and disposed of in accordance with law within a period of six months from today, and consequent revision of retiral benefits shall also be accorded, which will be paid within next one month.

In view of submissions made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition stands disposed of.
