Learned State counsel, on instructions from the official of the department, submits that the recommendation has been made by the Commission and the appointment letter will be issued to the petitioner within a period of two months from today.

Keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present petition is disposed of.

However, the learned State counsel is directed to make necessary compliance within a period of two weeks only from today.

In case, the compliance is not made within a period of two weeks from today then the petitioner will be entitled to claim Rs.10,000/- per day till the appointment letter is issued to him and the same shall be recoverable from the officials, who are instrumental in delaying the matter.

Respondents are also directed to grant the consequential benefits to the petitioner in pursuance of directions issued in the writ petition.
