Petitioner-proprietary firm had executed certain works for PSPCL. The claim regarding outstanding payments qua Work Order No.38 dated 23.12.2012, Work Order No.2 dated 26.11.2013 and Work Order No.2 of 2014 was directed to be disposed of within three months of the date of receipt of certified copy of the order dated 4.7.2016 passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court.

Since the necessary payments were not made, hence the present contempt petition was filed.

During the course of proceedings an amount of Rs.3,03,000/- qua Work Order No.38 stood paid. Another sum of Rs.29,112/- qua Work Order No.2 dated 26.11.2013 stands paid in Court today through a cross cheque dated 20.04.2017. It is states that a sum of Rs.12,000/- odd remains

to be paid qua Work Order No.2 of 2014, for which the no due certificate has been placed on record and copy furnished to the respondents by annexing them as Annexure P-4 with CM No.8317-CII of 2017. CM allowed. Annexure P-4 i.e. No Due Certificate is taken on record.

Learned Counsel for the respondents on instructions from Mr. Ranjit Singh, ASE/Chemical states that the outstanding amount qua Work Order No.2 of 2014 shall be released within one week from today.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the respondents, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to proceed any further in the present contempt petition.

Dismissed as infructuous.

The respondents shall be bound by their aforesaid statement.
