Petitioner has preferred the instant contempt petition with the allegations that the interim order dated 12.01.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No.264 of 2017 challenging the transfer order was not complied , in as much as the petitioner was not permitted to join back at Govt. Senior Secondary School, Panipat inspite of post being lying vacant.

Upon notice counsel for the respondents submits that the directions contained in the order have since been complied with and

therefore the present contempt petition has become infructuous.
