The petitioner/J.E. Sub-Station (Retd.) had filed CWP No.9408 of 2015 seeking direction to the respondent-authorities to grant ACPs due to him. The said petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondent-authorities to look into the matter/legal notice dated 24.12.2014 and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law within a period of two months from the receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the necessary relief has since been granted to the petitioner vide Office Order dated 20.10.2016 (**Annexure R-1**). Receipt regarding payment of costs of ₹ 11,000/-, imposed vide order dated 21.11.2016, has also been enclosed as **Annexure R-2**.

In view of the above, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
