In response to notice issued in the contempt petition, Learned State counsel had filed reply by way of an affidavit of Kamal Kishore Yadav, Director-cum-Special Secretary, Local Government, Punjab on behalf of respondent No.2 in the Court which is on record. The speaking order Annexure R-1 is annexed with the reply.

Relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“As per the above shown position and in compliance of the orders dated 23.12.2015 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Civil Writ Petition No.26957 of 2015, it is decided that the demand of the pay scale of 10300-34800+6600 to Assistant Divisional Fire Officer is not genuine, due to which it is not acceptable and after amending in 10300-34800+4600 Grade Pay, it is made as 5000/- Grade Pay and to pay Rs.6600/- Grade Pay, recommendation is already been made to Member Secretary of 6th Pay Commission. Apart from it, as far as the question of making amendment in the Grade Pay of the post of Fire Station

Officer and Sub-Fire Officer is concerned, in this regard, for making necessary amendment, recommendation has been made to Member Secretary of 6th Pay Commission. Therefore, by complying the orders passed by the Hon'ble Court, this case is being decided.”

It is apparent that the order passed by this Court has been complied with and the case of the petitioner has been recommended to the Member Secretary of 6th pay commission for making amendment in the grade pay for the post of Fire Station Officer and Sub Fire Officer.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Member Secretary to take action on the case of the petitioner before 6th pay Commission.
