In this Contempt Petition, the petitioner-wife, who had prayed for stepping up the pay of her late husband-Kamal Bagirath, working as Superintendent with the Punjab School Education Board, Mohali), with his junior Malagar Singh, has alleged that the respondents being contemnors herein, have wilfully violated the order dated 20.10.2015 passed by this Court in CWP No.21326 of 2014, directing the respondents to release benefits due to the petitioners, in terms of order dated 22.7.2015 expeditiously preferably within a period of two months, and thus, having failed to do the needful, they should be dealt with under the provisions of Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
