Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 16.12.2016 passed
by the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“In case, the petitioner is found to be entitled
for the said relief and his case is covered by judgment of
Constable Rajesh Kumar's case (supra), the necessary
benefits be granted to him within a period of two months
thereafter. In case, the petitioner is not found to be
entitled then speaking order be passed and petitioner is at
liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to him under
the law.”

Notice of motion.

On the asking of court, Mr.Harsimran Singh Sethi, Addl.A.G.,
Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that in case
no appeal is pending against the order passed by the writ court, needful
shall be done within two months..

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further
direction is necessary.

In case, order is not complied with within two months from

today, petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition. In such eventuality, this court shall consider imposition of exemplary costs on the officers responsible for delay/non compliance.
