The petitioner/Contractor was allotted the construction work of regulator-cum-fall at RD 94525 of Sabraon Branch for a total sum of Rs.1,15,00,000/-. Out of which, he had executed construction work of Rs.80,00,000/-. The said amount was stated to be outstanding.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the due amount has since been released to the petitioner by the Department concerned.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes the aforesaid factual submission.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
