COCP No.297 of 2017

In pursuance of order dated 25.03.2015 passed in CWP No.5356 of 2004 and order passed by the L.P.A. Bench, the petitioners have been adjusted as per the policy applicable to them. They have also been granted all benefits of continuity in service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the notional benefits have not been granted, whereas the petitioners are entitled for the same.

There was no direction for grant of notional benefits.

Since the petitioners have been granted the benefits of continuity in service, they can claim the notional benefits by way of filing representation to the competent authority.

In case such representation is filed by the petitioners within a period of four weeks from today, the respondent-authorities are directed to consider the same in accordance with law and policy applicable to them and pass necessary order thereafter within a period of two months.

The present contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
