Vide order dated 19.3.2015, the writ petition was disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to enquire into the allegations as mentioned in the representation made by the petitioner and to take action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of the order. When the aforesaid order was not complied with, the present contempt petition was filed.

Reply of the contempt petition was filed, wherein, it has been mentioned that necessary action has been taken, order dated 21.5.2015 was passed within the stipulated period and the same was sent to the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.

Since order dated 19.3.2015 has been complied with, nothing

survives in the present contempt petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
