The petitioner is a Contractor and had filed CWP No.19850 of 2016, seeking a direction for payment of the outstanding dues qua the work executed by him on the projects of Urban Development and Urban Housing Department, Punjab. This Court vide order dated 23.09.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) disposed of the writ petition, directing the authorities to release the outstanding dues.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondents has filed reply by way of an affidavit dated 10.01.2017 of Sh. H.S.Khullar, Divisional Engineer (C-1), Bathinda Development Authority, Bathinda, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned opposite Counsel. In the reply, it is submitted that the admissible due amount have since been paid to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid development, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
