Petitioner has preferred the instant contempt petition under Section 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 22.09.2016 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.16988 of 2014 whereby petitioner has assailed the action of the respondent-Agriculture Department, Haryana denying her appointment to the post of Agriculture Development Officer. The said writ petition was allowed and respondent department was directed to issue appointment letter to the petitioner within 30 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of that order and it was further ordered to balance the equities that petitioner was not entitled to the salary for the period she had not worked against the post.

Upon notice reply on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed.

In compliance of the orders dated 31.03.2017 Mr. D.K. Behera, Director Agriculture, Haryana is present in Court. He submits that the posting order shall be issued in compliance of the aforesaid order (P-1) passed by this Court in the writ petition. He also regrets the inconvenience caused to the Court and tendered unconditional apology which is accepted.

In view of the above assurance given by the officer present in Court, nothing survives in the present contempt which is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
