JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Eleven petitioners all retired from DAV Senior Secondary School (Lahore), Sector 8, Chandigarh have preferred the instant contempt petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for non compliance of order dated 19.07.2016 (**P-1**) passed by this Court in CWP No.21773 of 2016 whereby petitioner were held entitled to the leave encashment as per the instructions dated 2.6.2010 (Annexure P-7) issued by the Chandigarh Administration. However, at the same time, since the leave encashment is a part of the salary, the Management shall be

entitled to claim it as a part of salary in grant-in-aid from respondent nos.1 & 2 and the arrears of leave encashment to the petitioners shall be released within three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order along with interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of retirement till its realization.

Upon notice all the respondents have appeared. Separate replies on behalf of respondent nos.2 & 3 have filed wherein it is stated that the necessary payments have been made to the petitioners and accordingly the compliance of the orders dated 19.07.2016 (P-1) passed by this Court has been duly made.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners concedes to the aforesaid submission made on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand of the parties, nothing survives in the present petition for adjudication.

Dismissed as infructuous.
