Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 17.8.2017.

Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Inspector General of Police, Ambala Range, Ambala, to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 31.7.2017 (Annexure P-6) after hearing the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Petition is disposed of with a direction that the order be

complied with by the concerned authority at the earliest in any case not later than 2 months. In case, any fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed which would be deducted from the salary of the officer(s) responsible for delay/non compliance.
