JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioner had filed CRM-M No.39256 of 2016 seeking directions to the official respondents to look into his grievance, as detailed in the representations dated 05.10.2016 and 22.10.2016. The said petition was disposed of with a direction to the SSP, Bathinda (respondent No.2 therein) to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as detailed in representations dated 05.10.2016 and 22.10.2016, and to act in accordance with law. It was also ordered that the decision shall be taken within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the aforesaid directions have already been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned opposite Counsel.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
