DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Vide order dated 25.2.2014, a direction was issued to the respondents to decide the petitioner's claim as contained in legal notice within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that order dated 25.2.2014 has already been complied with as the legal notice of the petitioner has been decided and applications have been invited for allotment of plots and the draw of the plots will be held soon.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is waiting for the last many years for allotment of the plot but nothing has been done so far.

Since the direction was only to decide the legal notice of the petitioner within a period of four months and the same has already been decided, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy in case he is still aggrieved in any manner.
