Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 6.7.2017 passed by the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“In view of above, respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Rohtak is directed to look into the said representation Annexure P-3 and pass appropriate order within two months as per law after receiving the certified copy of this order.”

It is made clear that in case fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner, this court shall consider imposition of appropriate costs.
