Notice of motion.

On the asking of court, Mr. Harsimran Singh Sethi,
Addl.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioners allege violation of order dated 27.4.2017 passed by
the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“In these circumstances, without issuing
notice to the respondents the present petition is
disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to
consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioners
dated 1.12.2016 (Annexure P-5) within two months
from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, it is further directed that if any
SLP has been filed against the order/judgment of
Karanvir Singh's case (supra), the legal notice of the
petitioners will be decided within two months from the
date of decision of the SLP.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case order
passed by the writ court has not been complied with in letter and spirit,

needful shall be done at the earliest in any case not later than 3 months.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is necessary.

Disposed of.

It is made clear that in case fresh cause of action accrue to the petitioners to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court apart from proceedings under the Act, this court shall impose exemplary costs.
