Notice of motion.

On the asking of court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. A.G. Haryana,
who is present in court, accepts notice.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 25.04.2017 passed by
writ court, operative part thereof reads as under:-

“In the circumstances, this writ court is allowed and the respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioners for regularization of their services from the date services of their juniors were regularized. Necessary exercise be carried out within two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

At the outset learned State counsel submits that in case appeal has not been filed against the order passed by writ court, it shall be ensured that same be complied with at the earliest, in any case not later than three months.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is necessary. Disposed of. It is however, clarified that in the eventuality a fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, apart from initiating proceedings under the Act, it shall also impose exemplary costs which shall be deducted from the salary of the official(s) responsible for delay/non-compliance.
