The petitioner had filed CRM-M No.28218 of 2014 for directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to take action on the representation dated 09.01.2014 (**Annexure P-1**) as he was falsely implicated by the police officials under the NDPS Act. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 20.08.2014 (**Annexure P-2**), directing the respondent No.2-S.P., Chandigarh to look into the grievance of the petitioner specifically representation dated 09.01.2014 and take action in accordance with law.

Since the needful has not been done, the petitioner filed COCP No.3112 of 2014 (**Annexure P-5**) and the same was withdrawn with liberty to file an application in the aforesaid CRM-M No.28218 of 2014 so that some time frame may be fixed by the Court for finalization upon the decision of the representation of the petitioner.

Thereafter, the petitioner had filed CRM-M No.11212 of 2015, which was disposed of vide order dated 21.04.2015 (**Annexure P-8**) with a

direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter in the context of

representation dated 09.01.2014 afresh and decide the same by passing speaking order on the representation expeditiously within a period of one month from the receipt of certified copy of that order.

At the time of hearing today, learned Counsel for the parties submit that the present contempt petition has become infructuous as the representation of the petitioner has since been decided.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
