JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioners were claiming a provision for 40 feet wide passage for access to the unacquired land measuring 44 Kanal 17 Marla, wherein the petitioners are co-sharers. The demand for a wide passage was on account of the CLU obtained by them for construction of a School.

This Court vide order dated 16.12.2013 directed the authorities to look into the prayer and pass a speaking order.

Upon notice, it is stated that no CLU for the unacquired land has been obtained by the petitioners as per the information obtained from the Department of Town and Country Planning, Haryana, therefore, the prayer for providing of 40 feet wide passage is unwarranted. It is further stated that as per the prevailing Policy/practice, 11 feet wide passage for the aforesaid land already stands sanctioned and provided.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners concedes that the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
