Notice of motion.

On the asking of court, Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl. A.G.

Punjab, who is present in court, accepts notice.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 11.07.2017 passed by writ court. According to him, direction has not been complied within the period prescribed.

Learned State counsel submits that in case order is not subject matter of any appeal, necessary steps shall be taken expeditiously, in any case not later than one month.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is necessary. Disposed of. It is however, clarified that in the eventuality a fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, apart from initiating proceedings under

the Act, it shall also impose exemplary costs which shall be deducted from the salary of the official(s) responsible for delay/non-compliance.
