Petitioner-Meenu Singla @ Minoo Singla filed a suit against her father-Mangat Rai Aggarwal, brother-Arun Kumar and other family members, claiming enforcement of a family settlement dated 02.02.2015, whereby she was to receive an amount of Rs.20 Lakhs from her family members. In view of the statement made by the defendants, the suit was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 16.05.2015. Since the statement was not honoured by the defendants, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, a written compromise dated 26.04.2017 has been placed on record, whereby apart from Rs.2.5 Lakhs already received, another sum of Rs.5 Lakhs by way of demand draft has been tendered to the petitioner; as also six post-dated cheques of the stated amounts. Learned Counsel for the petitioner has acknowledged the payments as well as the contents of the compromise. A copy of the compromise is taken on record as **Mark 'A'**.

Learned Counsel for the parties are agreed that the present contempt petition has become infructuous in view of the terms of the aforesaid compromise.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous. The parties shall be bound by their stand in the compromise **Mark 'A'**.
