The dispute is between the petitioner-husband along with son on one side and the respondent-wife along with daughter on the other side. The petitioners had filed the present contempt petition alleging that the directions contained in the order dated 09.11.2015 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana, whereby the lower Appellate Court had upheld the order passed by the trial Court in the proceedings under the Domestic Violence Act qua the shifting to a separate room provided for the wife and daughter, from one side to the other within the same house.

In the present contempt petition it was alleged that the wife was not shifting to the said earmarked room in the residential house.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the parties submits that the present petition has become infructuous, as the matrimonial dispute

between the parties has been amicably settled.

Dismissed as infructuous.
