The present contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner on the ground that the order dated 16.3.2016 passed by this Court has not been complied with and the amount recovered from the petitioner has not been returned to him.

Admittedly, the recovery was already effected before passing of the final order and the petitioner is entitled for refund of the amount which has already been recovered from him but it cannot be said as non-compliance of the order and, therefore, the contempt petition is not maintainable. However, the petitioner is at liberty to move representation to the respondents and the respondents are directed to consider the said representation and pass necessary action in accordance with law.

In case any representation is made within one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the respondents are directed to consider

the same within one month thereafter.
