The petitioner along with others, Class-IV employees, had filed CWP No.23277 of 2015 seeking directions to promote the petitioners as Senior Laboratory Attendants from the date, their juniors had been promoted with all consequential benefits. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 02.11.2015 (**Annexure P-2**) with a direction to the D.P.I. (S.E.) to take into consideration the legal notice dated 12.08.2015 and representation dated 15.06.2015 and decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of the respondent has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the claim set up in the legal notice has since been decided by passing a speaking order dated 05.03.2016 (**Annexure R-1**), rejecting the claim of the petitioners.

In view of above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
