Learned counsel for the respondents submits that order passed by this Court on 27.5.2016 in C.W.P. No. 924 of 2014 has been complied with and the petitioner has been promoted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been promoted but financial benefits have not been released to him.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the benefits have been granted to the petitioner at par with other similarly situated persons.

Since the order passed by this Court on 27.5.2016 has been complied with, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to move representation to the competent authority within a period of one month and in case such representation is made, the respondents are directed to consider the same and pass necessary order in accordance with law.
